

# HOW TO MAKE BLESSED GRAPES

## MIRACULOUS SUSTAINING GRAPES FOR THE END TIMES

You need a Blessed Grape in order to bless other grapes. You can obtain a Blessed Grape from someone who has Blessed Grapes or you may seek a priest to bless a single grape or a cluster of grapes for you to then use to prepare Blessed Grapes.

### A. Buy fresh grapes, brandy, and glass jars if none at home.

- Buy brandy like Christian Bros, B&W Brandy or St. Remy. In the Philippines, the available brandy is **Napoleon V.S.O.P.** Do not use fruit or berry brandy because it will ferment instead of preserve.
- 1 kilo of grapes fits into **1 big glass jar** (about 1500 ml) or **two smaller jars** (750 ml). **Use glass jar only with plastic lid**, not metal lid which rusts. If you really cannot find glass jars with plastic lids, you may use those with metal lid but put plastic in between glass and lid to avoid rust. Clean the jars with soap and rinse very well with water. To sterilize, rinse the jars with boiled hot water then cool and dry before use.
- 1 kilo of grapes needs more or less 1 bottle of brandy (750 ml).
- If grapes are not available, any other fruit may be substituted if it is small like a grape and has similar consistency (shape and kind of fruit).

### B. Blessing the new grapes

1. While the grapes are attached to the bunch, wash them thoroughly in a basin with a solution of water with one or two drops of mild liquid soap and then rinse them well.
2. With scissors, cut each grape from the cluster, leaving a piece of stem on each one.
3. Take one Blessed Grape and rub it against one new grape making the Sign of the Cross on it while saying: **“In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, amen.”**
4. Fill  $\frac{3}{4}$  of each container with Blessed Grapes. Count the grapes as they are placed in the jar and write the total number on the lid or jar.
5. Once the jar is filled with grapes, pour brandy making sure all the grapes are submerged. It is good to leave a little airspace,  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 1 inch between the top of the brandy and the cover of the jar. This way the brandy will not spill when you open the jar.
6. Secure the lid and the grapes will be preserved until it is time to consume them. Keep out of direct sunlight.

**Blessed Grapes will sustain the people of faith during the time of the Antichrist, wars, famine, droughts, calamities, plagues, illness and times of food shortage.** These Blessed Grapes can be shared with others. In this way, others can prepare their own Blessed Grapes.

The Blessed Grapes can be eaten by sick people who cannot retain food. People who fast with the Blessed Grape will be protected from plagues, terrible diseases and other catastrophes. People will receive sustenance equivalent to the food, water, vitamins and minerals that the body needs.

**The brandy used to prepare them has medicinal value** (if you are sick take a teaspoon that taken with FAITH will cure).

**One grape will sustain two people throughout the day. A supply should be kept for up to six months or more (approximately 180 grapes).** The Blessed Grape will not sustain any person who mocks or does not believe. One grape will sustain two people for the entire day.
